

FC Type User Description Route Surface Access Numbers Types 1 Principal Park Road Public Roads which constitute the main access route, circulatory tour, or thoroughfare for park visitors. Rural Parkways 0001 - 0009 AS - Asphaltic Concrete Pavement (e.g. Natchez Trace) are numbered 0001 - 0009. 0010 - 0099 Rural Parkway BR - Brick or Pavers Road Bed 2 Connector Public Roads which provide access within a park to areas of scenic, scientific, recreational or cultural interest, such as overlooks, 0100 - 0199 campgrounds, etc. Park Road CB - Cobble Stone Road Bed 3 Special Purpose Public Roads which provide circulation within public areas, such as campgrounds, picnic areas, visitor center complexes, 0200 - 0299 CO - Portland Cement Concrete Pavement concessionaire facilities, etc. These roads generally serve low-speed traffic and are often designed for one-way Park Road circulation. GR - Gravel Road Bed 4 Primitive Public Roads which provide circulation through remote areas and/or access to primitive campgrounds and undeveloped areas. 0200 - 0299 NV - Native or Dirt Material Road Bed These roads frequently have no minimum design standards and their use may be limited to specially equipped vehicles. Park Road Note: Functional Classes 3 and 4 have the same route numbers because, historically, they were numbered similarly. OT - Other Materials Road Bed 0400 - 0499 5 Administrative Public All public roads intended for access to administrative developments or structures such as park offices, employee quarters, or utility areas. Park Road 6 Administrative Nonpublic All roads normally closed to the public, including patrol roads, truck trails, and other similar roads. Note: Functional 0400 - 0499 Classes 5 and 6 have the same route numbers because historically they were numbered similarly and often there is little Park Road distinction between these routes. For example, because utility areas and employee housing are often closed to the public, (Restricted Access) this restriction would result in classification of FC 6 rather than FC 5. 7 Urban Public These facilities serve high volumes of park and non-park related traffic and are restricted, limited-access facilities in an 0001 - 0009 urban area. This category of roads primarily encompasses the major parkways which serve as gateways to our nation's Parkway capital. Other major park roads or portions thereof, however, may be included in this category. 8 City Street Public City streets are usually extensions of the adioining street system that are owned and maintained by the National Park 0600 - 0699 Service. The construction and/or reconstruction should conform with accepted local engineering practice and local conditions. N/A Non-NPS Public 5000 - 5999 State, County, or City owned roads which border, traverse, or provide access to Park Facilities or Locations. Non-NPS Roads roads are not assigned functional classes and are driven for GPS and Video Log only.

A park road system contains those roads within or giving access to a park or other unit of the NPS which are administered by the NPS, or by the Service in cooperation with other agencies. The assignment of a functional classification (FC) to a park road is not based on traffic volumes or design speed, but on the intended use or function of that road or route.

The historic route numbering system also included a 300 series for interpretive roads, and a 500 series for one-way roads. There are approximately 250 roads nationwide which are designated by the 300 and 500 series. The numbers for these roads will be maintained for reporting consistency. However, since these interpretive and one-way routes are not as clearly tied to a specific functional class, the 300 and 500 series will be discontinued for future use.
